Pray for God to draw to Himself the district officials who reprimanded him and gave him an ultimatum: stop believing in Christ. Ask God to strengthen and encourage Sed, who chose to follow Christ. and relinquish his position. 3. **Parliament** / Pray for Rt. Hon. Caroline Dinenage, Baroness Lancaster of Kimbolton Conservative Party Member of Parliament for Gosport since 2010. Pray for Caroline, her husband and two children Source: Wikipedia.

4. **Unreached People Groups** / Pray that God will raise up the people, resources, and prayer necessary for the gospel to effectively reach the 31,574,000 member Mahratta unspecified group of India. Source: www.joshuaproject.net

5. **Cannabis** / Police and Crime Commissioner Alison Hernandez has warned police can no longer ignore the damage caused by cannabis. Speaking at a Police Chiefs 'conference she warned the "enforcement of drugs and drug-dealing in this country has been pathetically weak on class B drugs". Pray that woman considering this horrific procedure will determine to spare their child from this evil practice. Source: Life News

8. Each Country's Leader / Pray for Supreme Leader Ali Hoseini-Khamenei, the primary leader of Iran (87 million), will be moved by the hand of God to see the positive impact Christians have in his country and be moved to stop the severe persecution in Iran allowing people to live in peace.

9. **Bibleless People Groups** / Pray that the Bwatiye (1,200,000) people of Nigeria will have the New Testament translated into their language. They currently do not have the Scripture in their heart language. Source: Wycliffe

14. **Pakistan** / On September 22, 2013, two suicide bombers carried out an attack outside All Saints Church in the city of Peshawar Pakistan killing 127 people (including 37children) and injuring 170. Pray for all impacted by this atrocity that despite the pain they may know the peace of God which passes all understanding and deep-rooted joy. May many come to a personal knowledge of Jesus as they witness the love of God demonstrated by those who have suffered so deeply.

15. **Gambling** / Employing a more "robust" methodology the Gambling Commission, the industry regulator, now estimates problem gamblers make up 2.5 per cent of the British population. Responding to the findings Gambling Minister Stuart Andrew said: "This new survey

presents a higher quality picture of gambling participation and harm". Pray for anyone who struggles with this addiction and for government leaders seeking to curtail this craving, Source: The Christian Institute**The**

16. **Prime Minister Rishi Sunak** / thanked Christians and churches for a campaign called Shine Your Light bringing hope to communities across the country at Christmas. Over 54,000 Christians from more than 440 churches took part in events in high streets, villages, shopping centres and town halls among other public places. Dr Jonathan Oloyede, Convenor of the National Day of Prayer and Worship stated the campaigns' goal was to bring Christ back into Christmas and for people outside of the church to understand the true meaning of the festival. 17. **Christian Ministries** / 24-7 Prayer – "24-7 Prayer is an international, interdenominational prayer movement, with a vision to revive the church and rewire the culture through non-stop night and day prayer. The ministry is currently is based in 78 countries. Pray for God to grant highly effective strategies for work.

18. **Eric Liddell** / The renown Scottish athlete won the 400m at the Paris Olympics 100 years ago. During World War 2 Eric was interned in a Japanese prison camp in China where he had served as a missionary. After the war it was discovered, he had given up the opportunity to be released to a pregnant woman. A fellow internee, Stephen Metcalfe, later wrote of Liddell: "He gave me two things. One was his worn-out running shoes, but the best thing he gave me was his baton of forgiveness. He taught me to love my enemies, the Japanese, and to pray for them." Pray that Eric's Christian testimony will continue to have a powerful impact throughout this year.

19. **The Family** / Pray that divisions, strife, and disharmony in marriages and families would be healed through the power of forgiveness, sought through Christ. Pray for a spirit of humility to reign. For help see www.HisPeace.org.
